#### INTRODUCTION

This book has been designed to assist you in פרשה learning and review. Most of the questions in this book focus on the basic information presented specifically in the text of the Chumash. Occasionally, the answer can be found in מ"ש". In both of these cases, the source for the answer is noted below each question. Therefore, you have the opportunity to use this book alongside the חומש to find the answers. Please note that many questions have more than one correct answer! This is indicated by a square icon next to the question.

In addition to the questions derived from the text of the Chumash, there are questions on "additional knowledge" that is associated with the given Parsha (for example, Dinim and Yedios Klalios.) These questions are marked with a circle icon. For these bonus knowledge questions, your teacher may either provide text for you to learn or simply share the answers for their knowledge.


At the conclusion of each set of פרשה questions, there are key פסוקים provided from the פרשה. These מוקים can be used in multiple ways toward different goals.
