He is also the creator of the CIJE Math Challenge, now in its second year and serving more than 1,000 students. A strong advocate for cooperative learning, differentiated instruction, and equitable access to mathematics, David is dedicated to helping teachers refine their practice and empowering students to become confident mathematical thinkers.
